6. How do you feel the author portrayed the millennial generation in this novel? Did you feel it was accurate?
7. If you could give a piece of advice to your younger self, like Jenna the millennial life concierge tries to do, what would it be?
8. What do you hope to find in book three? How do you think the end of *The Bad Break* will set up the events for the next book?
