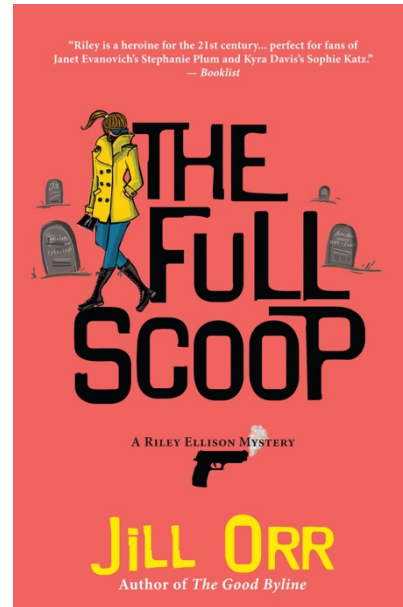


Reading Group Guide: The Full Scoop

5. Do you think Holman and Lindsey Davis make a good match? Why or why not?
6. Do you think Shannon Claremore was complicit in Megan's crimes? If Shannon didn't know what Megan did, should she have? How about Wyatt – does he share any of the blame?
7. What role if any does Megan's disability play in her crimes or how she managed to get away with doing the things she did for so long?
8. What do you think is next for Riley personally and professionally? How has she grown and developed since THE GOOD BYLINE?
